Goal no. 1: No Poverty

- 7 targets
- 53 events
- 37 publications
- 1175 actions

Targets

- 4 years and more of progress against poverty erased by COVID 19
- Rising inflation and impacts of war in Ukraine further slowed down the process
- Additional 8 million workers pushed into poverty as of 2020

Goal no. 2: Zero hunger

- 8 targets
- 43 events
- 14 publications
- 1074 actions

Target

- About 1 in 10 people still suffering from hunger
- Nearly 1 in 3 people lack regular access to adequate food
- Soaring food prices affects a little less than half of the countries globally

Goal no. 3: Good health and well being

- 13 targets
- 18 events
- 35 publications
- 980 actions

Targets

- COVID 19 threatened decades of progress in global health
- 500 million and more people infected
- 15 million deaths
- 92% of the country's health services disrupted
- Decreased global life expectancy
- 100, 000 plus front-line workers dead

Goal no. 4: Quality education

- 10 targets
- 21 events
- 8 publications
- 1520 actions

Targets

- 147 million children missed over half of in – person instruction
- Inequality in education further worsened during the pandemic
- Improvement in school infrastructure after classrooms reopened

Goal no. 5: Gender equality

- 9 targets
- 32 events
- 34 publications
- 1285 actions

Targets

- 40 year more at current pace for equal representation of women in national political leadership
- 43% of women aged 15 – 49 years do not make own informed decision when it comes to sex and reproductive health care
- 1 in 4 women aged 15 and above subject to intimate partner violence at least once in their lifetime

Goal no. 6: Clean water and sanitation

- 8 targets
- 18 events
- 32 publications
- 920 actions

Targets

- Over the past 300 years over 85% of the planet's wetlands lost
- 3 billion or more people do not if the water they drink is of quality
- 4 times increase in pace of progress required to meet the target by 2030
- 733 million plus people face high and critical levels of water stress

Goal no. 7: Affordable and clean energy

- 5 targets
- 12 events
- 32 publications
- 845 actions

Targets

- Progress in electrification slowed due to the challenge of reach those hardest to reach
- 2.4 billion people still use inefficient and polluting cooking systems
- Share of renewable is only 17.7% of the final energy consumption

Goal no. 8: Decent work and economic growth

- 12 targets
- 54 events
- 36 publications
- 1588 actions

Targets

- Global economic recovery hampered by
 - New waves of COVID 19
 - Rising inflation
 - Supply chain disruptions
 - Policy uncertainties
 - Labor market challenges
- 1 in 10 children are engaged in child labor worldwide
- Further set back by Ukraine crisis

Goal no. 9: Industry, innovation and infrastructure

- 8 targets
- 40 events
- 14 publications
- 779 actions

Targets

- LDCs behind in manufacturing post pandemic
- Small scale industries lack access to financial support for recovery
- 2.3 billion passengers in 2021 compared to 4.5 billion in 2019
- 1 in 3 manufacturing jobs impacted negatively by the crisis

Goal no. 10: Reduced inequalities

- 10 targets
- 34 events
- 11 publications
- 775 actions

Targets

- Pandemic caused rise in between income inequality
- 5,895 migrants lost their lives in 2021
- 1 in 5 people have faced discrimination at work
- Global refugee figure at record high and higher after Ukraine crisis

Goal no. 11: Sustainable cities and communities

- 10 targets
- 37 events
- 16 publications
- 936 actions

Targets

- Municipal solid waste a concern as cities grow
- 99% of the urban dwellers breathe polluted air
- Less than 1/3rd of the Sub – Saharan people lack access to public transportation
- 1 billion and more slum dwellers globally

Goal no. 12: Responsible consumption and production

- 11 targets
- 10 events
- 13 publications
- 1264 actions

Targets

- Consumption and production root cause of
 - Climate change
 - Biodiversity loss
 - Pollution
- Majority of the world's electronic waste not being safely managed
- 17% of total food wasted at consumer level

Goal no. 13: Climate action

- 5 targets
- 16 events
- 33 publications
- 1520 actions

Targets

- Drought estimated to displace 700 million people by 2030
- Climate finance falls short of \$100 billion yearly commitment
- Rising global temperature leading to more extreme weather
- By 2100, sea level will rise by 30 – 60 cm

Goal no. 14: Life below water

- 10 targets
- 61 events
- 38 publications
- 2586 actions

Targets

- Ocean - Planet's largest ecosystem in danger
 - Plastic/ marine pollution
 - Over – fishing
 - Acidification
 - Ocean warming

Goal no. 15: Life on land

- 12 targets
- 15 events
- 31 publications
- 935 actions

Targets

- Almost 90% of the global deforestation is due to agricultural expansion
- 10 million hectares of forests destroyed every year
- 40, 000 species approximately at risk of extinction in the decades to follow

Goal no. 16: Peace, justice and strong institutions

- 12 targets
- 20 events
- 11 publications
- 830 actions

Targets

- A quarter of the population live in conflict affected countries
- 1/3rd of the world's population, mostly women fear walking alone during dark
- 100 million people forcibly displaced worldwide
- Corruption a major concern

Goal no. 17: Partnership for the goals

- 19 targets
- 135 events
- 62 publications
- 1722 actions

Targets

- Rising debt burden a concern for developing countries during pandemic recovery
- 63% of the population have access to the internet
