To prevent deeper regional chaos, global powers must prioritize
inclusive diplomacy over military favoritism.



- Power vacuum in Syria leads to global power struggles
- Gaza and Lebanon remain unstable; Hezbollah not defeated
- Iran faces internal risk amid Khamenei's aging leadership
- U.S. pressure & normalization strategy may worsen tensions
- Israel's potential annexation of the West Bank threatens Saudi normalization
- New conflicts could easily draw the U.S. back into war
