1. Learning negligence

- a. Negligence happens when someone causes harm or damage to another person because that someone is not careful enough.
- b. The duty of care is the duty not to cause harm or damage to another person
- c. Negligence is the most common ground for an action in tort

2. Learning can, may, must/have to

- Can expresses ability
- May expresses possibility
- Must/have to expresses necessity
- *Can, may, must/have to* are not followed by *to*
- The main verb does not have a final -s
- The main verb is not in a past form.
- The main verb is not in its – *ing* form.
